The SWAT type units of the Australian police fall into two primary categories. One is Along the lines of the Territorial Response Groups of Tasmania and the Northern Territory. These are small (only ten personnel in NT) part time units who in major incidents would be expected to only contain the incident until the arrival of TAG. Requires **Police** package.
