Your PCs have final emerged from the dungeon laden with loot prised from the clutches of their slain foes. Heroically returning to civilisation, they find a tavern, divide up their loot and relax. Then they ask "So what are the people like here, anyway?" At this point, the GM likely panics and either replies "nothing special" or improvises a series of similar, one-dimensional (and ultimately forgettable) NPCs. (After all, most GMs have got barely enough time to prepare the next adventure; preparing dozens of NPCs the PCs might interact with is likely a long way down their "to do" list.)

Be Awesome at Designing NPCs banishes this problem! Within, you'll find tables designed to enable the busy GM to quickly and simply create hundreds of memorable, rounded NPCs. With just a few dice rolls, the GM can generate an NPC's notable physical traits, personality traits, mannerisms, current activity and profession, leaving him more time to concentrate on the adventure at hand!

As important as flavoursome, well-designed combat encounters and adventures, interesting and evocative NPCs can make a dungeon, village or town come to life. No one remembers the faceless NPC that sells the PCs their gear, but the merchant with a squint, bad breath and an interest in taxidermy is an interesting addition to an otherwise banal event. Similarly, the PCs will remember the horribly scarred, yet

friendly street urchin long after they have forgotten his unremarkable companions.

Unique and interesting NPCs are great fun for the GM. Not only can he get in on the role-playing action, he can also create interesting moral situations for the PCs and impart useful (or useless) information to the PCs.

That said, designing scores of interesting NPCs can crush even the most motivated GM's will to live. (And in any event, most of us simply don't have the time). That's where this book comes in.

Within you'll find tables designed to help you create interesting, memorable NPCs in seconds! You can use these tables for literally anyone—the drunk popping up the tavern

bar, the grouchy watchman pestering the party or the conman trying to fleece the PCs out of their hard-won wealth.

We've also included a comprehensive selection of names from over a dozen real-world ancient cultures along with tables crammed full of names for all the major demi-human races appearing in most editions of the world's most popular role-playing game.

A GM shouldn't use these tables to design every NPC the party encounter—that's overkill and if every NPC is special and memorable it will just cause confusion and frustration.

Of course, sometimes a GM doesn't have any time at all (or more likely the PCs wander off in some unforeseen direction). That's why this book also presents 20 pre-generated NPCs so that the GM has a decent bank of interesting folk at his fingertips. I'd recommend you spend some time creating your own "emergency" NPCs so that you never run out!

Finally, I hope you enjoy this book and that it makes running your campaign just a little bit easier and more fun. I'd love to hear what you think. DESIGNING MINOR NPCs

The tables herein are not designed to create fully fleshed-out, highly detailed NPCs. As you look through them you'll quickly notice there are no game statistics in sight. In fact, the tables don't even list the sex, race or class of the NPC.


Rather, the goal of these tables is to enable the busy, time-pressed GM to quickly generate memorable and easy to portray minor NPCs—the type of people the PCs meet as they haggle for goods in a marketplace, drink in a local tavern or simply move through a city in search of adventure.

A GM could also use these tables to generate the basic details of reoccurring NPCs before fleshing them out more fully. Such individuals require more work and thought (and possibly statistics) and in this case these tables should be viewed as a basic jumping-off point for further design.

GENERATING AN NPC

To generate an NPC, first roll on the table below to determine how many times to roll on each subsequent table. Then roll on the appropriate tables on the following pages noting the NPC's characteristics. Discard any contradictory or inappropriate results. Alternatively, a GM can simply look through the tables picking and choosing which entries to use.

- **Table A (Physical Traits):** This table presents 100 physical traits you can use to describe the NPC.
- **Table B (Emotional/ Behavioural Traits):** This table presents 100 basic emotional traits or behavioural hooks that you can use to bring life to the NPC. This table won't provide enough information to develop a fully rounded NPC, but it does provide a starting point.



- **Table C (Mannerisms):** Every NPC has mannerisms—stuff they do when they talk with people or interact with the world. Combining such with an NPC's emotional state and appearance creates a memorable individual.
- **Table D (Activity):** This is an optional table. Sometimes, the NPC's activity is dictated by where the encounter occurs. For example, if they meet the NPC in the bar, he is unlikely to be riding a horse. Use this table in conjunction with common sense! This table focuses on urban areas – so listed activities including shopping, drinking, working and so on. Some activities are appropriate for the countryside, and a GM should reroll any inappropriate results.
- **Table E (Profession):** This table is optional. For example, if the PCs are looking for a blacksmith, rolling on this table is spectacularly pointless; simply allow them to find a blacksmith. The listed professions focus heavily on normal professions – blacksmiths, coopers and so on. The table does not include listings for specific adventuring classes (such as fighter, wizard and so on) or enable the PCs to accidentally encounter a king, high priest or other such luminary.

PRE-GENERATED NPCs

Of course, some GMs are crazy busy and so we've also included 20 pre-generated NPCs which a GM can plug into his campaign with a single die roll! Simply roll on this table or choose a set of options that suit your needs.

If you are running a campaign set in a town or city, it is worth generating your own set of pre-generated NPCs so players don't catch you short.

DESIGNING MAJOR NPCs

Great NPCs can make or break an adventure. The crusty, fastidious wizard with a terrible secret and the one-legged, foppish assassin dreaming of revenge are memorable folk the PCs will remember long after the adventure is over. Designing NPCs isn't hard, and it can be just as rewarding as creating a challenging encounter or new magic item. Cool NPCs add flavour and depth to an adventure or campaign.

Some NPCs only interact with the PCs for a few moments. Others—recurring villains, allies, foils and so on—deserve more design time. These notes provide a framework a time-crunched GM can use to quickly and easily create memorable NPCs.

- **Name:** A name can make or break an NPC. Joke names, real-world names or clichés should be avoided like the plague. Names should fit with the locale and campaign world. If the folk of a kingdom use Norse-style names using an Egyptian name is either bad design or marks the NPC as someone different (and therefore perhaps more interesting).
- **Background:** Everyone comes from somewhere. No matter how brief, an NPC should have a back-story. The PCs don't necessarily have to learn all about the NPC's background, but having a solid grasp of where a person came from enables a GM to better roleplay the NPC.
- **Personality:** Some NPCs hate elves, others are perpetually confused or drunk. Yet others are colossally boring or incredible extrovert. You don't need to design an NPC's entire personality, but giving him one or two traits creates enough detail to roleplay a memorable encounter.
- **Mannerisms:** Does the NPC lick his lips when nervous or does he refuse to make eye contact with strangers? Adding a notable mannerism—preferable one a GM can act out—is a great way of highlighting an NPC's nature and provides a handy way for the players to remember the NPC.
- **Appearance:** Don't overload the PCs with details. Provide enough to give a suitable first impression of the NPC. An NPC's appearance can give important clues to its profession, current activity and so on. A battered and bruised peasant may have just been attacked by a local lord while a priest wearing pristine robes could have a phobia about getting dirty (or perhaps never leaves his temple to tend his flock).
- **Distinguishing Features:** In the same fashion as a mannerism, a distinguishing feature is a terrific means of differentiating the NPC. Whereas a mannerism is likely something the GM roleplays, a distinguishing feature can be richly described, and act as a kind of signpost or name badge for the NPC.
- **Hooks:** Some NPCs can act as hooks into adventures and side treks. Others might have a special reason for interacting with the PCs. Adding a hook to a memorable NPC is a great way of bringing the campaign world to life.

A VILLAIN'S MOTIVATION

Giving a villain a believable motivation is so much better than simply, "they are evil."

- **Excitement:** An adrenaline junkie, this villain is doing what he is doing for kicks. He may find planning, implemented, escaping and so on exciting.
- **Justice or Retribution:** This villain wants justice for a perceived wrong against his person. His actions stem from a deep desire or need for retribution against the person or persons responsible for his woes.
- **Selfish; Feels Personally Entitled:** The world owes this villain a living – he feels personally entitled to take whatever pleases him whenever he wants. He lusts after material gain and has a complete disregard for others.
- **Poor Self-Esteem:** With a low opinion of himself, this villain seeks to gain the respect and recognition he craves through his evil, nefarious plans. This villain normally enacts plots that are easily attributable to him – how else, after all, would be gain the recognition he so desires?
- **History of Abuse:** This villain has been abused either mentally or physically and views such causal, wanton violence as normal. Alternatively, given he has suffered, he might have a need to make others suffer as he has done.
- **Social Acceptance:** If a villain comes from an evil culture or family, he may be enacting his plan to gain acceptance from those important in his life.
- **Mad:** The villain could a schizophrenic manic depressive or have one of any number of other mental conditions. Ironically, his madness may hold the key to defeating his scheme.
- **Religious or Political Convictions:** Driven by unshakable religious or political convictions, this villain is one of the vilest and intractable. Often working at the behest of a "higher power," he may be mindlessly following dictates or working toward his goal to improve his standing in an organisation.
- **Love:** A villain in love might be truly evil or may simply be carrying out his love's desires. Such folk make for interesting opponents. If the PCs work out what is going on, they have a chance at redeeming or manipulating the villain.
- **The Greater Good:** Sometime a villain works toward what he perceives to be the greater good but does so using vile, abhorrent methods. Such a villain may be waging a war of extermination against a certain race or culture. Alternatively, he could be working to destroy an object or place because it has the ability to release an ancient, forgotten power
- **(Delusions of) Grandeur:** This villain has decided he is the best person to rule the "little people." His scheme is the way he plans to achieve this goal. He may, or may not, be right.

NAMING NPCs

One of the big problems GMs face when designing their campaigns and adventures is NPC names. NPC names are tremendously important because it's a part of the design that players interact with (in the same way as they interact—hopefully—with treasure). NPC names thus are a powerful way to nurture—or shatter—a player's suspension of disbelief.


I'm just terrible at coming up with decent sounding names. Even (or especially) when I'm actually GMing. The PCs often spend quite a long time in a pub relaxing, gambling and talking with the locals. Coming up with lots of appropriate, flavoursome names on the fly is difficult and tedious. In particular, I find that when I pause for a moment to come up with a good-sounding name, it is blindingly obvious that I am making something up. This imperils the players' suspension of disbelief and flags up the NPC up as a minor person not worth the time to design.

Using the tables is simplicity itself. No longer will GMs be reduced to calling every NPC "Bob!" Simply choose a culture and roll of the relevant tables to generate a name. For the GM's convenience, each culture has a separate table for male and female names.

A GM can even use specific set of names to a different culture or kingdom in their campaign or even for non-human groups. For example, certainly a nation of elves with Egyptian or Sumerian names would be a unique twist to a campaign!

Of course, some ancient cultures (notably the Anglo-Saxons, Greeks and Vikings) didn't use surnames. Instead they used:

- Nicknames; for example, Aelfgar the Swift.
- Added "son of [father's name];" for example, Cassander son of Avel. In this instance, the GM should roll again on the relevant table to determine the NPC's father's name.
- Added the individual's trade or profession; for example, Gorm the Blacksmith.
- Added "of [place name]" to differentiate individuals. In these instances, the GM should insert an appropriate place from his campaign. For example, Odda of Twin Ford.
- **Special Note:** Also included are some surnames of Anglo-Saxon origin for GMs who do not care too much about historical accuracy. These would not have been used in ancient times.





