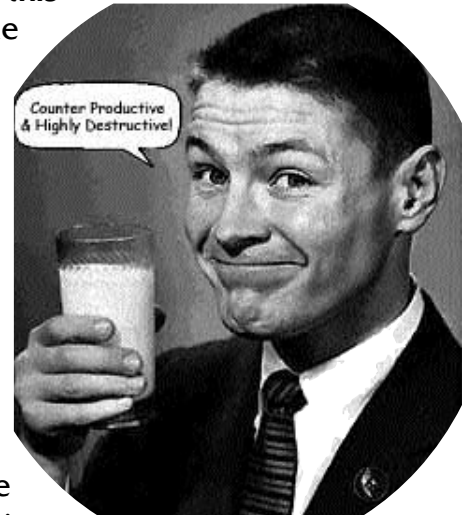

Hold-outs

Ceska Diplomat

Released in '54, the Ceska Diplomat revolver is a perfect self defense option for the executive with a need for subtlety. Its slim design and smooth lines give it excellent concealability. The most effective feature of this gun, however, is that it has two barrels and it can fire them both at once. This added firepower, combined with the fact that it has follow up shots, leaves the Diplomat a definite contender in the growing hold out pistol market. For game purposes, treat the double shot as a shortened burst.

Ruger "Pug" Heavy Holdout Pistol

Mercs, cops and bounty hunters worldwide have always needed a reliable backup pistol that packed the firepower necessary to take down the largest of targets. For years, their search has been in vain. They either got low power but highly concealable holdouts or they had to settle for less concealable



heavy pistols. Now, Ruger offers the “Pug” heavy hold-out pistol. Ruger has designed a compact frame around the very powerful heavy pistol round in order to bring you the most powerful pistol in its class. This pistol performs at levels very near those of standard size heavy pistols, but offers concealability as good as all but the smallest of holdouts.

Steyr GB-50

The Steyr GB-50 is considered by many experts to be in the top 10 pistols ever designed. Its bench test results consistently show unparalleled accuracy and hundreds of testimonials from mercs and bounty hunters world wide are a tribute to its reliability. This weapon is easily concealed because of its slimline design, and Steyr also offers free grip personalization (p. 82, *Cannon Companion*), requiring an extra “delivery meeting” at no extra charge. The GB-50 accepts all pistol accessories and ammunition.

Ceska Scorpion S



Ceska’s newest design is based on their wildly popular Black Scorpion MP, and has added many new features that make an already good gun an even better one. The Scorpion S has several new features that bring it up to par with the best of its class, and it still remains one of the most economically-priced weapons on the market. New features include caseless ammunition for better magazine capacity, a smartlink system and integral sound suppresser. Given the quality and price of this weapon, it is expected to sell well.

Enfield Lightning Machine Pistol

Enfield designed the Lighting at the request of the British Army in order to fill the need for a light service pistol that could provide heavy firepower if necessary. By building the weapon with a large ammo capacity and auto-fire capability, Enfield was awarded the contract and the Lightning has been adopted by the British military. The weapon comes from the factory with only a laser sight, and the weapons are generally modified to fit each departments needs. These weapons are fairly common with British runners and mercenaries and are considered reliable and rugged.

Fabrique-Nationale PA-10

The PA-10 is one of the most common military and security sidearms in Europe. The weapon has become popular because it is compact, reliable and capable of fully automatic fire. European Megacorps will typically use this pistol because it is small but on autofire it packs a wallop. The PA-10 comes with a rating 2 gas vent and either laser sight or smartlink. For both models FN manufactures an extended 30-round magazine (which reduces Concealability by 2).

Makarov 57

One of the newest machine pistols from the Russian arms factories is the Makarov 57, based on a century-old pistol design from the former Soviet Union. The two primary features of the Makarov are selectable fully-automatic fire capability mated with a high-density 25-round helical magazine. This weapon has become a favorite of both eastern European military officers and security personnel, and has also started to make inroads into the North American arms market.

Heavy Pistols

Beretta 100S

Smooth lines, excellent accuracy, and deadliness all define this new heavy pistol from Beretta. Featuring a removeable silencer, a laser sight and classy looks, this gun is fast becoming a favorite of corporate security and "Company Men" worldwide. Also available is a smartgun variant.

Bond & Carrington MP-11

Made in the same factory as their famous custom designer guns, this heavy personal defense option is designed to fill the gap between Bond and Carrington's extravagant custom guns and their more down to earth IWS counterparts. This heavy pistol is loaded with standard features, which include a



rating 2 gas vent, integral laser sight or smartlink, detachable shoulder stock, and 30-round extended magazine. This gun may seem expensive, but it does allow the common man to own a bit of a legend in firearms.

Browning Defender 10



With the burst-firing heavy pistol market growing at a tremendous rate, Browning enters the fray with the Defender 10. Using a powerful but controllable round, the Defender strikes a good balance between recoil and cyclic rate. Given its reliability and resistance to adverse climates, this is an excellent candidate for military service. Of course, this makes it all the better for civilian use.

• You can dunk this in toxic waste and it will still fire reliably. The recoil is manageable, but could use gas venting, and it hits like a truck. Get one if you need compact firepower.

Colt Gladius Magnum

The death of the revolver has long been debated by gun enthusiasts, usually to the detriment of the venerable wheelgun. If the service life of the Gladius is any indication, the revolver will live on for decades. More law enforcement personnel have used this weapon for a backup gun than any other gun—including autoloaders! The Gladius has been sold in nearly every country in the world and has spawned more knockoffs than almost any other weapon. The reason for all of this attention is that the Gladius is probably the most reliable weapon you can buy. It simply does not fail. When you combine that with this weapons punch and great concealability for its class, you have a weapon that can hardly be beat.

Colt M1911A3

Look familiar? It should. This is a brand new version of the definitive semi-automatic pistol. Colt's designers recently perfected the mold for the M1911A3 and are ready to turn out the new version by the thousands. The new modifications to this immortal model include only a slightly modified upper receiver (to enable it to use Firepower™ ammo, see p. 24) and a re-arranged handgrip-frame layout to enable it to accomodate the integral smartgun circuitry. The smartgun optics run through the receiver to the front of the weapon, so you wont notice any difference from the original until you tear it down.

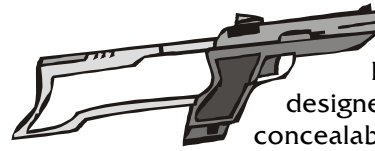

Given their success with the Manhunter, Colt designed yet another heavy pistol for the general market. This weapon, like its predecessor, is known for its reliability and firepower. Given Colt's success with the Manhunter, this gun should sell well.

Fichetti Military XI

Officially adopted by the CAS military in 2052, this extremely effective burst-firing heavy pistol has found its way to the personal defense market. Using a very powerful round and rating 1 gas vent recoil dampening, this weapon delivers devastating punch with reliable accuracy. It comes with an integral laser sight as standard and is also available in a smart variant.

Heckler & Koch OHWS (Offensive Handgun Weapon System)

In the early 1990's, the government of old wanted a new weapon system to replace several different weapons currently in service in the armed forces' SOCOM (Special Operations Command). It needed to be able to withstand the different environments that SOCOM units sometimes operated in: salt water, desert and extreme cold were just a few. Well, the Pentagon got what it wanted: a large, indestructible, semi-automatic pistol with integrated electro-optics.

With their innovative Polymide frame design, some of which exists in today's weapons, H&K were able to cut recoil forces down to less than 16% of that of a normal heavy pistol. The OHWS is made up of the following components: polycarbonate frame semi-automatic pistol, an incredibly effective silencer, a single-action/double-action trigger assembly, and an under-barrel optics system made up of a flashlight, visible light laser and an IR laser.

And the recoil is almost non-existent! You can empty the clip in 2.5 seconds and keep the group in a 10 cm circle. Well maybe not you, chummer, but I've done it.

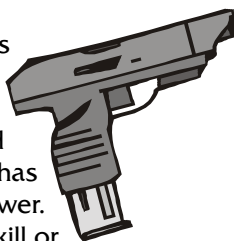

Ingram Mk IV

This compact heavy pistol was designed specifically for the UCAS security branches (FBI & NSA). It chambers a round designed during the 1990s that has been a hallmark of handgun firepower. This pistol was designed to either kill or knock down any target using not only the firepower of the round, but also a special High Explosive Squash Head round that guarantees knockdown, as well as destroying armor. Featuring an integral smartlink and gas vent (rating 3), this weapon is a deadly addition to the armories of UCAS government agents. This weapon suffers double recoil penalties when used in burst fire mode. See the *Munitions* section (p. 99) for details on the HESH ammunition.

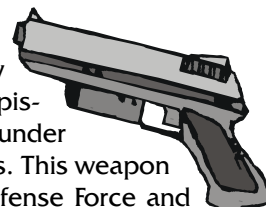

Another hit from the designers at Seco. The M-85 heavy pistol is a battle proven service pistol that has proved its reliability under the most extreme circumstances. This weapon was designed for the Israeli Defense Force and has become a soldier's favorite because of its firepower and hardiness. Seco has only now been able to release this fine pistol into the general market after completing their exclusive contract with the IDF. The M-85 should sell very well in the merc and bounty hunter market where function is more important than fashion. The black macroplast frame and indestructible laser sight are the epitome of practicality in a market where chrome usually outshines reliability.

StreetArms "Impact" Over/Under Shotgun Pistol

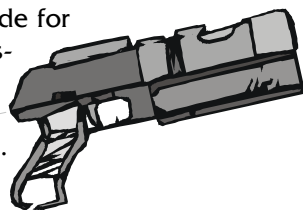


Everybody knows that shotguns are one of the most effective weapons to use on the street where people wear mostly light body armor. StreetArms took one of the perennial favorites, the sawed-off double-barrel shotgun, and rebuilt it for the Sixth World, creating a pistol-sized shotgun that virtually guarantees a takedown versus most targets. It is an over/under model to increase concealability and comes with an integral smartchoke for increased accuracy and hitting power. Much like the Thunder grenade pistol (page 96), this shotgun has become an immediate favorite among orks and trolls working the streets of North America.

Walther Hammer

Walther is known worldwide for its slimline, concealable pistols. The Hammer heavy pistol is a definite departure from light holdout pistols. The frame of this pistol is large and robust in order to handle the punishing recoil of the massive superheavy pistol round that has become all the rage these days.



In addition to a powerful cartridge, Walther uses a high capacity helical magazine that gives the Hammer a larger magazine than any superheavy pistol on the market today. Combine these features with integral smartgun electronics and you have one of the best pistols that you can buy.

SUBMACHINE GUNS

Defiance AT-900

Usually sticking to shotguns and tasers, Defiance has branched out into the SMG market. The AT-900's many modern features make it competitive in this very tough section of the firearms market. Standard features include a rating 2 gas vent and a laser sight, while optional features include smartlink and a folding stock.



Heckler & Koch MP-9

This new Heckler & Koch submachine gun is a dedicated compact assault weapon. Its small size and heavy firepower make it ideal for small scale covert operations and hostage rescue teams. Its standard features include a folding stock, rating 3 gas vent and integral smartlink.

H&K Type 75

In the late 30's Heckler & Koch introduced a slightly different model to its submachinegun class. It was entered into the competition that Interpol's SOU (Special Operations Unit) was coordinating to come up with a new multi-purpose weapon that would lighten the load of their average operative.

The Type 75 is a compact system, reminiscent of



the venerable Colt Commando and H&K's own MP-5SD. It has a stock that collapses from a full-open length of 30 cm to a fully closed length of 5 cm without sacrificing any strength. The

shock pad is also only one centimeter thick with the effectiveness of a normal shock pad. Gas venting is handled in a redundant series of evacuator chambers throughout the integral sound suppression system to the point where no flash is visible to the naked eye. The result of venting gases through the unique multiple chamber system also helps to reduce the supersonic crack of rounds being fired. The audible sound is actually quieter than that of a subsonic round and only the sound of the action is detectable past three meters.

The Type 75 comes standard with smartlink electronics, a shock pad, and an integral rating 2 gas vent combined with a sound suppresser. The sound suppresser/gas vent system are a permanent part of the weapon and cannot be removed or upgraded.

Sandler Model II

Sandler's second entry into the firearms market. The Model II is a much improved step up from the TMP. It is not prone to frequent breakdowns like its predecessor and is reliable in all climes. It comes standard with an integral laser sight and rating 2 gas vent.

Steyr SS60

The Steyr SS60 is a compact reliable SMG that has come into favor with small corporate units worldwide.

The bullpup design of the weapon allows for a longer barrel than most SMG's and performs more like a rifle than a submachine gun. The weapon comes standard with smartlink and rating 2 gas vent recoil compensation.

StreetArms Auger

The Auger is a submachine gun sized weapon that is designed for the heavy-firepower lovers out there (you know who you are). The designers took a venerable Magnum round, built a reliable combustible casing around it, then designed a hard-hitting weapon system to deliver it. The high points about the Auger include



compact size, reliability, strength and the obvious advantage of having assault rifle power and capacity in a sub-machine gun package.

The StreetArms factory can cast this in either an steel/aluminium package (4 kg) or a plastic-nylon weave (3 kg). Neither design lacks any reliability or robustness.

Some people like them heavier and some like them lighter without the added signature that metals can give off. The steel/aluminium version is a little easier on the recoil due to its higher mass, but that is the only difference between the two.

The Auger is capable of selective fire and comes with integral shock pads and a rating 3 gas vent to help compensate for the higher-than-normal recoil. (The plastic-nylon model gets a +1 to the total recoil due to its lighter weight.) Both come standard with integral smartlink circuitry.

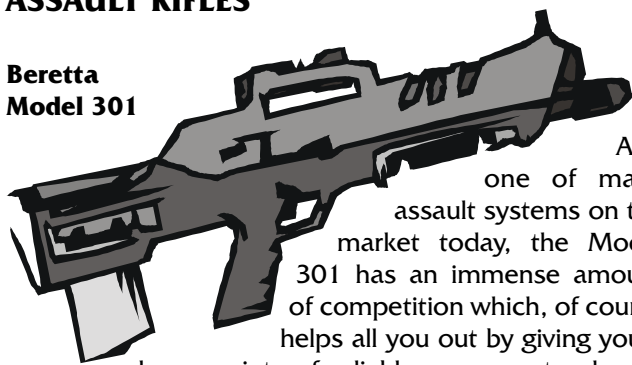

Beretta Model 301



As one of many assault systems on the market today, the Model 301 has an immense amount of competition which, of course helps all you out by giving you a large variety of reliable weapons to choose

from. Beretta has lived up to its reputation by designing a very reliable and modern assault rifle, with all the features that a rifle should have, including a rating 2 gas vent, smartlink system, integral 6-shot mini-grenade launcher and magnification 2 optics system. The beauty of this weapon is that it has all of these features but isn't nearly as bulky as most assault systems. In addition, it is a joy to shoot, and most professionals are impressed by its performance characteristics.

Browning M-30

The Browning M-30 is a rugged assault rifle designed to perform in the worst of environments. It has earned a reputation for reliability in situations where lesser rifles would malfunction. MET 2000 has labeled the M-30 the "Hum-Vee of battle rifles," referring to the legendary reliability of the favorite off-road vehicle. The M-30 is a plain vanilla rifle that only includes a laser sight and magnification 1 optics system, but can be customized with any standard rifle accessories.

You want a big gun? Well, here ya go. Originally designed by an underground arms manufacturer in Germany, this gun pops up every once in a while. This is not a small gun by anyone's standards. It's big, a little cumbersome and literally a kick to fire, especially in the out-of-place burst mode. It has a 6-round magazine, which provides enough ammo for two three-round bursts or six single shots. The frame is also designed with smartlink electronics as a standard feature. The shock pad is of the heavy duty variety and, believe you me, it's nice to have it there. That's it. There isn't too much to this gun, but we like it!

SPECIAL WEAPONS

Ares GAP-9



The Ares GAP-9 is the latest attempt by the arms market to build an effective guided ammunition small arm. This advanced pistol uses special ammunition that locks on to a target and may make small course changes in flight in order to hit that target. In order to do this the weapon system uses special advances in technology. First, the weapon has a micronized electromagnetic field detector that is capable of recognizing the unique EM fields generated by all people and animals. This detector locks onto the target selected by the operator through the use of the integral smartlink. Locking on requires a Simple Action, during which the character must have a clear line of sight to the target. Make a Pistols test against the normal, ranged-based target number with a -6 modifier. Apply a +2 modifier for every magnetic field (such as living beings, although some objects may also fall under that category) within 1 meter of the intended target. Next the weapon uploads the EM field pattern into a microcomputer located in the ammunition itself. Once loaded, the ammunition uses this pattern to track the target.

Course changes in flight are regulated by the microcomputer and facilitated by small piezo-electric “tendons” that actually alter the shape of the projectile in flight. The rounds of the GAP-9 are much larger than a standard heavy pistol round in order to fit all of the detection equipment in, but the GAP-9 uses heavy pistol ranges. A small explosive charge has been added in order to ensure efficient takedown. The entire process of target acquisition, EM detection, and firing take only slightly longer than the average target acquisition time. Users will find that after a short period, the GAP-9 will perform as quickly and more efficiently than other less advanced weapons. The rules for the GAP-9 ammunition are in the *Munitions* section on p. 99.

Note: This pistol was one of the most-discussed items among the update team. After much deliberation the conclusion was reached that, given *Shadowrun*'s technology level, this gun and its ammunition could exist; however, the costs of production would be prohibitively high. It is therefore recommended that gamemasters who are unsure about this weapon either ban it or alter its game statistics to Availability 16/3 weeks, Cost 20,000¥, Street Index 10, and Legality 4P-K. This will restrict the item to the toughest of opposition (like Knight Errant's Firewatch units) and runners who really work hard for it.

Ares MicroSquirt

The MicroSquirt is an evil little design from Ares, a chemical delivery system that uses mixed chemical/DMSO pellets and compressed air to deliver its payload. Chemicals in the MicroSquirt are mixed in a special container (included with the weapon) and then injected into gelatin capsules (20¥ for 100) which are loaded into the gun. A small compressed-air cartridge good for 5 shots powers the whole arrangement. The MicroSquirt is too small to accept any accessories except personalization. It uses hold-out pistol ranges.

Caracal

A few of our R&D engineers got a wild hair up their collective arses and came up with a weapon previously seen only in the imagination of various comic and animation artists: the Caracal. It is not known why they named it after the desert lynx, but who can argue with the results? It's the amalgamation of a full size assault rifle, two submachine guns and a grenade launcher into a single weapon system. The different thing about this system is that the overall length is shortened by placing the handgrip in almost the center of the weapon and building the frame around it, containing the barrels, venting, electronics, ammo and firing mechanisms. A tight fit is ensured by an air-pressurization system that activates upon smartgun linkage.

The user places their firing arm (left or right) into the cavity at the rear and makes contact with the control grip. The smartlink electronics, interfaced on the control grip, control all aspects of the weapon as otherwise it would be quite difficult to manage that type of firepower. Only one system can be used at a time, but the



twin SMGs are linked and fire at the same target at the same time. The linkage design is just short of a work of genius as it has a parallax-nullification system to ensure that both barrels are shooting at the same target.

We apologize to those bigger folks out there, but this design only allows for a forearm of a certain size limit to fit in the system. The designers tell us that they are working on a bigger model, just for trolls. We can't wait to see it!

The rifle system has a 30-round clip, the twin SMG system has two separate, 30-round clips and the grenade launcher has a 6-round, tubular, internal magazine (much like some hunting shotguns). Treat the twin-SMG system as a single weapon for purposes of firing but treat damage like normal for the amount of rounds being fired (e.g. if two three-round bursts are fired, treat it like a six-round burst for recoil and damage).

General Electric M-72 Incendiary Device

The M-72 ID is an old but extremely effective portable flamethrower that was produced for the US Army. This weapon had served admirably in various conflicts and has seen action all over the globe. After a short service life, it was decided that the modern US Army did not have a need for a portable flamethrower; then with the dawning of the Sixth World, the practicality of an incendiary device was truly realized. The UCAS military has begun deploying the weapon at the squad level as a general incendiary device and anti-paranormal creature weapon. The weapon uses a com-

pressed air system that projects napalm up to 15 meters from the gunner. The weapon may be used to hose an area, or it can fire short bursts for pinpoint incineration. This weapon has become a favorite of shadowrunners and bounty hunters worldwide and StreetArms is proud to offer the M-72.

See the rules for flamethrowers on page 29 of the *Cannon Companion*. The M-72 uses taser ranges, but all other flamethrower rules from that book apply.

IWS Rocket Rifle

This year at the Paris Arms Show, IWS unveiled its Rocket Rifle. This revolutionary new weapon fires a small rocket not unlike those of normal rocket launchers except smaller. Where a normal rocket launcher might be too large, the rocket rifle is not much larger than a grenade launcher. In addition, the rifle has a 5 round magazine for sustained fire. The weapon gives fire teams the benefit of powerful munitions without the bulk of a full size rocket launcher and it may also fire guided rockets with no modifications. The 2058 model features a smartlink and laser sight (for guidance; the target number modifiers of the two are not cumulative). See page 99 for a full list of available rockets. 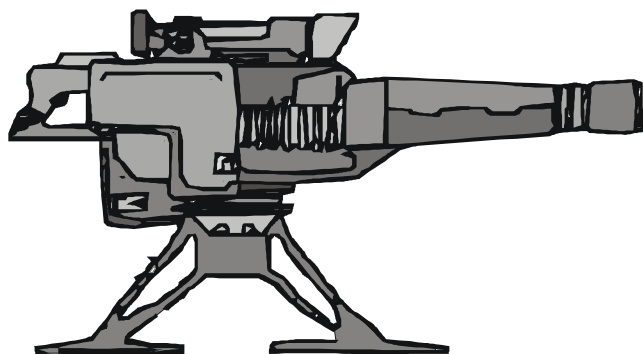

Winter Systems Restraint Cannon

The Winter Systems Restraint Cannon is one of a new type of weapons called vortex guns. Vortex guns use an explosive charge to generate a doughnut-shaped shock wave that can knock over and stun metahumans at short to medium ranges. This shock wave has three very desirable features for a stun gun. First, the shock wave expands with range so that multiple targets may be engaged at the weapon's optimal distance. Secondly,

the weapon is non-lethal except at point-blank range. Last, but most significantly, the ring-shaped shock wave is a perfect carrier for crowd-control chemicals because the air movement in the ring keeps the chemicals inside the wave until it is disrupted by an object in its path. The Restraint Cannon is a crew-served weapon that can be used in any situation where non-lethal methods are necessary to keep the peace.



Vortex guns are stun weapons that use the shotgun range table; the weapon is treated as a shotgun with a choke of 4 for purposes of determining damage and spread at increasing range. The ammunition for the weapon consists of small explosive charges that impose heavy weapon recoil modifiers; the ammunition is fully described on page 100. The weapon is also equipped with a chemical reservoir that will hold up to 50 doses of any chemical—typically, law enforcement departments will load 50 doses of their favorite crowd control chemical like tear gas, or they will use 25 doses of an injected chemical like MAO and include 25 doses of DMSO. The effect of the chemical is calculated after the initial Stun damage is assessed.

Winter Systems Restraint Carbine

The success of the Restraint Cannon prompted Winter Systems to design a smaller, more portable version of their crew-served vortex gun. The Restraint Carbine is a less powerful weapon, but it can be carried and used by a single operator. If used within its accepted range, the Restraint Carbine is actually a more effective weapon because of its portability. The weapon comes standard with a low-light and thermographic sight, and can be outfitted with a smartlink.

This weapon uses the same rules as the Restraint Cannon (above) except the damage is 10S Stun. The

effective range is that of a heavy pistol, and the effective choke is 3. The chemical reservoir only may hold up to 24 doses of chemicals. In addition, smartlink systems only provide a -1 modifier to target numbers instead of the usual -2.

MUNITIONS

Ares GAP-9 Ammunition

This ammunition is used exclusively by the Ares GAP-9 (p. 97). It provides 4, 6 or 8 complementary skill dice for use when firing at targets for which a lock has been acquired; see *SR3* p. 97 for rules on using complementary skills.

(For gamemasters who consider the Ares GAP-9 bleeding edge technology, it is suggested to change the Availability to 16/3 weeks (18/3 weeks for the Skill Rating 8 version), the cost to 500¥, 700¥ and 900¥ for each Skill Rating respectively, the Street Index to 10 (12 for the Skill Rating 8 version), and the Legality to 4P-K.)

High Explosive Squash Head (HESH)

The special HESH rounds do not offer any greater armor penetration than normal rounds, but they use the weapon's full Power Level as the Knockdown target number (see *SR3*, p. 124) and also increase the weapon's Damage Level by one if their base Power Level exceeds the target's armor rating. In addition, armor degrades by two points for every time its rating goes in the weapon's Power Level, rather than by only one point (p. 96, *Cannon Companion*).

Mini-Missiles

Small missiles which can be fired by the IWS Rocket Rifle. Like other missiles, they have an Intelligence rating that helps in firing them more accurately; see *Resolving Rocket and Missile Fire* in *SR3*, page 120, for details. Mini-missiles cannot be fired from standard missile or rocket launchers such as the IWS Multi-Launcher described on page 279 of *SR3*.

The anti-armor missile has an anti-vehicle warhead, as described under *Attacks Against a Vehicle* on page 149 of *SR3*. HEP (High Explosive Cratering) missiles are resisted with one-half (round down) the target's Ballistic armor rating. Half the damage, rounded up, is



Physical, the other half is Stun. They have no blast radius, and only cause damage to a target taking a direct hit.

Note: These missiles are identical to, and interchangeable with, the ones described in the *Cyberpunk Conversions*.

Shotgun Mini-Grenades

These are mini-grenades designed to be fired from shotguns; they cannot be launched from standard grenade launchers, or from any other weapon that does not use shotgun ammunition. They were developed for the Mossberg M-712 Multi-Weapon System

(p. 90) but can be fired from any shotgun. All standard grenade types (see *SR3*, p. 283) can be had in a shotgun mini-grenade variant, with a -2 modifier to the Power Level. (The effects of grenades that do not cause damage is left up to the gamemaster's discretion, but should be in the order of 10% to 25% less than that of comparable standard grenades.)

Vortex Ammunition

This is the ammunition used by the Winter Systems Restraint Cannon and Restraint Carbine (page 99). It cannot be used in other types of weapon.
