THE TRAVELLER PROGRAM EXCHANGE (TPX)

Here is more good news for you computer users! There is a computer data-base (BBS) for Traveller® which you can donate your information to or draw upon its growing list of programs. The project, called the Traveller® Program Exhange, or TPX, is run by John C. Meyers, a gentleman who keeps having to navigate his way through all of his data. As of now, TPX is for Apple users, but John is trying to find someone to open up a Commodore side for TPX.

Some Apple programs available from TPX include data conversion, personnel recruiting, sector dot map generator, demographics

generator from secto files, complete Gvurrdon sector data, and incomplete Far Frontiers sector data. If you desire copies on disk, send a pre-formatted blank disk with a list of programs you desire. THE TRAVELLER DATA BASE PROJECT (TDBP)

SUBSCRIPTION FEES FOR SECURITY LEAK

Finally! One year of this newsletter is \$4 in the US, \$7 overseas. (APO, FPO, and Canada use US rate in all cases.) Single copies are \$1.25 in US, \$2 overseas.

SECURITY LEAK fanzine rates are \$12 in the US, Canada, APO, and FPO. Overseas rates are \$15 per year. Single issues are \$3.50 in the US, \$4.25 overseas.

Both publications are quarterly. SLF is 12-16 pages (8½" x ll"), illustrated. SLN is 4 pages (8½" x ll"). All back issues are considered to be single copies, unless you are buying a complete year's worth of back issues— then pay only a one year's normal rate. SLF now on issue #2, SLN on #2. [§]

CORPORATE PROFILE: INALONA FOODS AND AGRICULTURE

Strictly an agriculture grower and food producer. Inalona has no subsidaries, but is rather broken into branches. Created around 320 by a Terran firm, Inalona has found reasonable success in most of its undertakings. Many agricultural worlds in the Old Expanses host newly constructed Inalona facilities and crop-fields, and plans are being drawn up to expand into the sectors coreward of the Solomani Rim. The administrative offices for Inalona are on Mars in the Terra system/Solomani Rim. Because Terra is already heavily industrialized, non-agricultural businesses are encouraged to move to Mars in order to preserve Terran natural wildlife. Inalona has no agricultural or processing dealings or other properties in the Terran system. Inalona provides nearly one-fifth of all of Terra's annual food consumption, and almost 5% of the Sol subsector's needs. On the sector scale, Inalona provides about 7% of the total food and agricultural demand. Inalona does not provide or produce fertilizers. The firm is known for its delicous and always fresh produce and fruits. Some of the grape-fields which Inalona cares for yield many of the best wines in the entire sector. [§]
